Public Safety has \$62,818.23; Fire Millage has \$28,065.42; Fire Department Escrow has \$3,793.84 and there is \$2,144.47 in the Lake George Road Special Assessment account.

<u>POLICE REPORT:</u> Deputy Jerry Cypret gave the following police report: there were 183 calls in the month of November with 110 of the calls handled by the Township deputies.

1. Resignation of Szerlag from ZBA, new appointment.
