1. Supervisor Ochadleus reviewed a letter received from the Lapeer County Health Department regarding new department rules. Supervisor Ochadleus reviewed the summary of changes.

 - a) The Fire Department assisted a couple of departments on structure fires.

- 4. <u>ATTORNEY REPORT:</u> Attorney Gildner reported that he worked on an agreement for fire department members to receive physicals from physicians.
